



Survey Response Demographics



1. How comfortable are you with in-person classes resuming in August?








- Students and staff will be required to wear masks during the school day.

- Temperature checks will be required before entering the building.








- 4. What are your main concerns about sending your student back to school? Please select all that apply.




What are you looking forward to about your student returning to school? Please select all that apply.


7. What is your preference for accessing materials for remote learning?



8. What are your concerns regarding technology if your student is learning from home? Select all that apply.








10. What is the best way for you and your student to receive the most up-to-date information from the <u>school</u>? Select all that apply.
